The Foundation Stage is about forming a strong basis from which to slowly develop our Sight. During the Foundation we develop a spiritual or shamanic practice suited to our own natures, through experiential exercises out on the land we begin to uncover our essential self, our authenticity and learn to use it to inspire our lives. It is about beginning to open to the numinous within the natural world and to learn directly from Her. It is about balancing the aspects of our being: body, emotion, mind & spirit, so that we may invite more harmony into our lives.

The Foundation stage consists of FIVE workshops once a month. We meet on Fridays until Sunday afternoon.

What to Bring

Because we will be working outside much of the time, please bring seasonally appropriate clothing. Lots of layers are best. Please bring sunscreen and sun hats for hot days and plenty of warm layers for cold days. Please bring warm, waterproof clothing as well as stout footwear as you will at times be invited to work with the horses. Wellingtons can be useful when the grass is wet. Please also bring something waterproof to sit on the ground for awareness exercises. Please note that you will be asked to tie up loose hair and remove rings (apart from wedding rings), and earrings when working with the horses. Please bring hard-backed A4 notebook and something to write with.

A vegan lunch and refreshments will be provided on both days. Please let us know in advance of any special dietary requirements.

It is hereby agreed and acknowledged:

That PARTICIPANT voluntarily agrees to participate in activities at STABLE including ridden work, working on the ground with horses, group work with horses and other equestrian-related activities. That PARTICIPANT may, at times, obtain certain services from STABLE, its owners, officers, employees or agents, including but not limited to horse-riding and/ or other equestrian-related activities.

1. The PARTICIPANT acknowledges the STABLE, its owners, officers, employees or agents make no representations or guarantees regarding the safety, training or suitability of any horse that the PARTICIPANT may come into contact with.

The PARTICIPANT understands that upon mounting the horse or taking up the reins, the PARTICIPANT becomes primarily in control of the horse and that the STABLE, its owners, officers, employees or agents, are not responsible for the PARTICIPANT'S actions. The PARTICIPANT further agrees not to abuse, misuse or deliberately agitate the horse as these actions may result in increased risk to him/her or others.

2. The PARTICIPANT fully understands and is aware that horses are unpredictable by nature and have unpredictable reactions to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals. The PARTICIPANT understands that when frightened, angry or under stress, a horse's natural instinct is to jump forwards or sideways; to run away from danger at a trot or gallop; to kick; to buck; to rear up or bite. It is also understood that horses are extremely powerful and may step on PARTICIPANT'S feet or other body parts. PARTICIPANT understands that in the event of a fall off the horse, the fall distance will generally be from 3 to 6 feet and could cause serious injury.
3. The PARTICIPANT acknowledges that the STABLE, its owners, officers, employees or agents are not responsible for acts, occurrences or elements of nature or a particular location that can injure a person or scare a horse, cause it to trip, fall or react in some other manner. These elements include thunder, lightening, rain, wind, wild and domestic animals, insects, other people and horses which may walk, run, fly near, bite and /or sting a horse or person, irregular footing on cultivated or wild land which is

subject to constant change according to weather, temperature, natural and man-made objects. The STABLE, its owners, officers, employees or agents have not inspected and make no representations or warranties concerning the safety or condition of any locations which the PARTICIPANT may be utilizing.

4. The PARTICIPANT acknowledges that he/she has been advised to wear proper attire when participating in equestrian-related activities including long trousers, boots with a heel and a riding helmet when mounted on a horse for their own personal safety.
5. The PARTICIPANT is aware that equestrian-related activities, including but not limited to horse-riding are not recommended for pregnant women.
6. The PARTICIPANT hereby releases or waives any claims known or unknown that they may have now or in the future against the STABLE, its owners, officers, employees, agents or successors for any damages including bodily injury, death and other damages to themselves, their minor children, their horse(s) or other personal property arising from any occurrences or activities or any activities or occurrences on the premises of the STABLE. The PARTICIPANT further understands that this is a total release of all liability whether known or unknown and knowingly waives any and all rights pertaining to this matter.
7. The PARTICIPANT agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the STABLE, its owners, officers, employees and agents against any act or omission which is later alleged to be a cause or contribution to a claim for injury, damages or death. Further, it is mutually agreed that this document constitutes a disclaimer and waiver and that this agreement is the full, total and complete agreement by the parties on the issues expressed herein.
